- Montepulciano d’Abruzzo DOC and DOCG: Known as the “Cavaliere”, this is the red wine of Abruzzo, a true expression and pride of the Abruzzese people. Produced in all four provinces of the region, it has been recognized as a DOCG wine since 2003. It pairs beautifully with various types of meats and aged cheeses.

- Gole del Salinello: A protected area safeguarding the habitat of the Salinello Gorges, carved over millions of years by the Salinello River.
- Gran Sasso and Laga Park: This park features two main mountain groups: the Gran Sasso Massif and the Monti della Laga.
- Abruzzo, Lazio, and Molise National Park: Established in 1922, it is Italy's oldest and most prominent national park, home to unique flora and fauna found nowhere else in the world.
- Majella National Park: Rugged and imposing, it features steep, compact slopes on its western side and extends into the Femmina Morta plateau at high altitudes, while its eastern slopes are carved by the wildest ravines in Abruzzo.

- Civitella del Tronto: Known for its imposing Bourbon military fortress, which was the last to surrender to the Piedmontese invasion in 1861.
